# II. Summary.

Why does the Bible include this psalm twice—here and, in virtually the same form, in the book of Psalms (18, DRL)? This, the longest of David's psalms, is used in two ways. The book of Psalms is Israel's collection of hymns and lyrics for use in the service of worship. Here, near the end of the narrative of David's career, the poem is used to bring out the spiritual center of Israel's most beloved king.<sup>1</sup>

Tom Wacaster summarizes this chapter in the following way. There is an introduction, setting forth all that Jehovah is to David (1-3). The record of David's sufferings and peril, and the mighty power by which he was delivered, (4-19). The reason for this deliverance (20-30). The blessings which David received in his life (31-45). Joyful thanksgiving and acknowledgment of all God's mercies (46-50).
